

Riverbay Service Update, April 3, 2020

This is a Riverbay service update for April 2, 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. We wish to advise you of the following:

Income Affidavits

HCR has just advised us that the deadline for cooperators to return their 2019 Income Affidavits has been extended again. The new submission date is July 31, 2020.

Any assessed surcharges will be billed effective Oct. 1, 2020. Riverbay will notify you of any surcharge assessment by Aug. 31, 2020. This year, you are not required to notarize the affidavits.

Testing Site

New York State has set up a Coronavirus drive thru test site at Bay Plaza in the proximity of the AMC Theaters. The hours of operation are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Sunday.

Tests are by appointment only. The number to schedule an appointment is, 888-364-3065.

Please note that the Bronx Clergy Task Force is offering transportation services for Co-op City seniors who need a ride to their scheduled test appointment. The transportation request number is, 718-547-8854.

Disinfection Response

If you have confirmed information of a positive Coronavirus diagnosis or related death in your building, please contact the Riverbay Call Center. This will allow us to immediately begin our disinfection protocols. Your information will be held in strictest confidence.

Carrying Charge Payments

Despite rumors to the contrary, monthly carrying charges are still due at the first of the month. You can mail in your payment to the Riverbay Finance department, or pay electronically at [GoZego.com](https://www.gozego.com) (Powered by PayLease).

In addition, the carrying charge deposit boxes in the three community centers are open and available for dropping off payments. Please adhere to social distancing requirements. The Dreiser Center elevator has been reprogrammed to stop on the lower promenade level to assist those who want to drop off carrying charges there.
