Power Plant

To ensure our new boiler is operating at peak efficiency, the power plant will perform steam blows starting around noon tomorrow, March 18. If you live or travel in the vicinity of the Power Plant, you may hear some noise emanating from the plant. This is expected, and is not cause for alarm.

Extermination Services

Riverbay Corporation is suspending all pest control appointments until further notice. However, we will continue to address any emergency conditions such as bedbugs and pest infestations.

Apartment Work

As conditions evolve, we may have to reduce some of the non-essential services in apartments.
